The flotilla website hosting account was hacked, and several phishing sites and malware programs were placed on the server. The intrusion was identified on 6/4/2011, and the website was taken offline for approximately 12 hours to identify and remove the unauthorized content. The hosting service verified that all unauthorized content was removed, and the website was brought back online. It is unknown how the hacker was able to gain access, but there may have been a vulnerability in a calendar function that allowed submission of events to the calendar administrator without using a password, which may have enabled the hacker to place the files on the server. As a precaution, that calendar function has been disabled, and all administrator passwords associated with the account have been changed.
